

W3Source Tutorials – iPhone 2.0 Bluetooth Stereo Pairing

Using OAKLEY O ROKR (or other Stereo headset) with an iPhone

Description

This tutorial shows you how to properly pair a Bluetooth Stereo headset, such as an O ROKR, with an Apple iPhone for both phone conversations and stereo music listening.

Requirements

- Apple iPhone or iPhone 3G running iPhone 2.0 or higher
- A Bluetooth Stereo headset such as an Oakley O ROKR
- Icombi or Odio Bluetooth Stereo adapter (or similar)

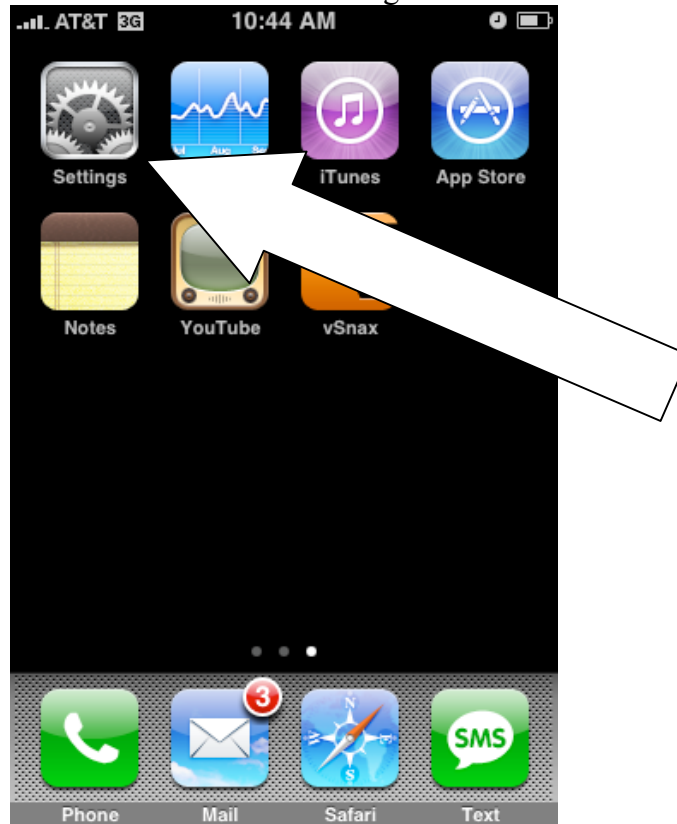
Assumptions

- You have already activated the iPhone for use and loaded it with preferred music.

Pairing Headset with an iPhone for Mobile Communications

The following procedure will connect your headset to your iPhone for Handsfree communications only.

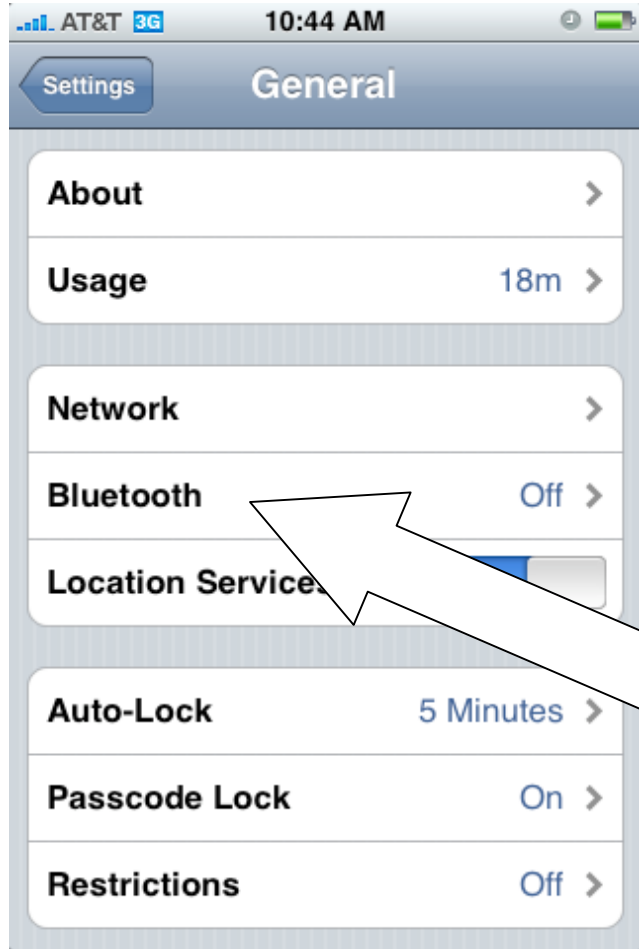
1. Press and hold the Call Button on the left stem of the O ROKR until the indicator light on the inside of the right stem turns solid red.
(Review your headsets manual for instructions on how to enter pairing mode.)
2. On the iPhone find the Settings icon.



3. Select the “General” settings option.



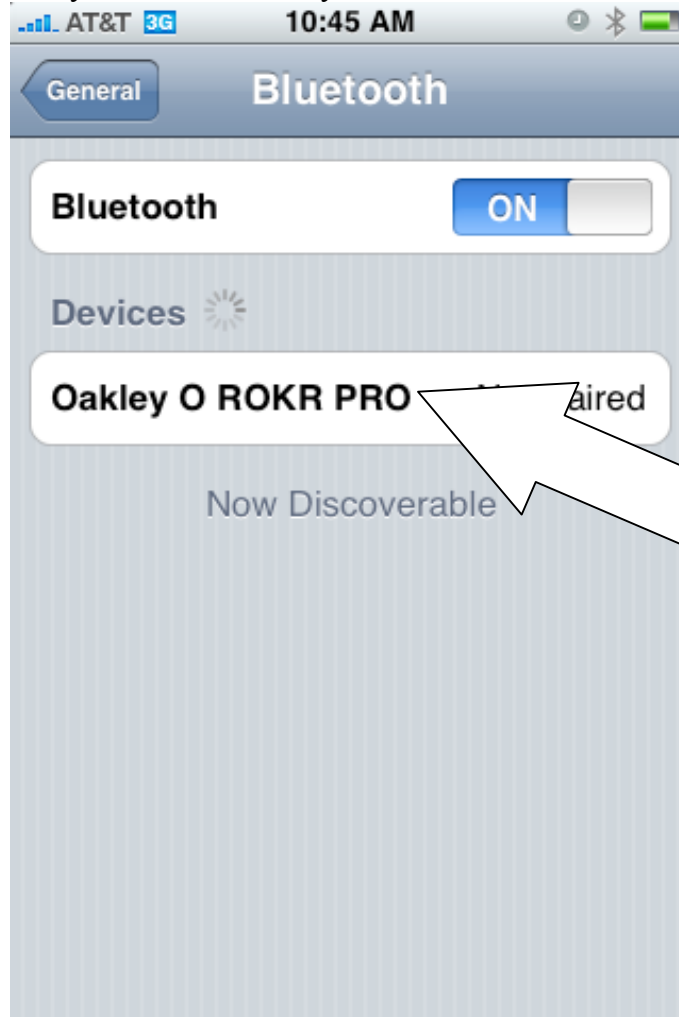
4. Select "Bluetooth"



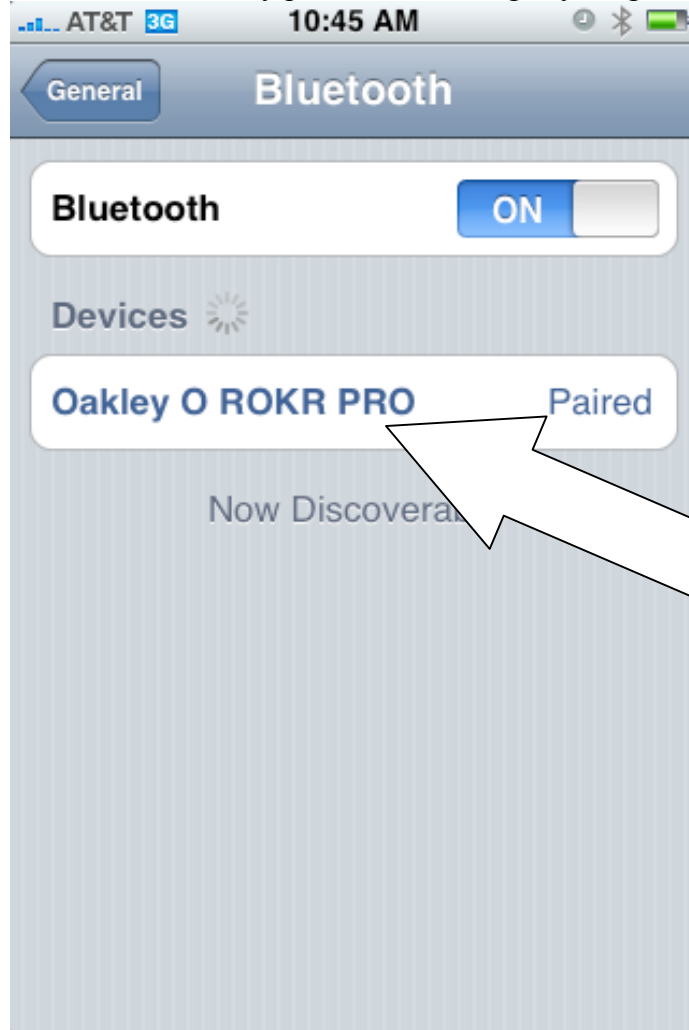
5. Turn Bluetooth On



- The iPhone should now automatically “Discover” the Headset. In my case it’s an Oakley O ROKR Pro



7. To pair the headset with the iPhone, select the headset in the list of devices. If your headset's security code is four zeros ("0000"), after a few moments it should automatically pair without doing anything else.



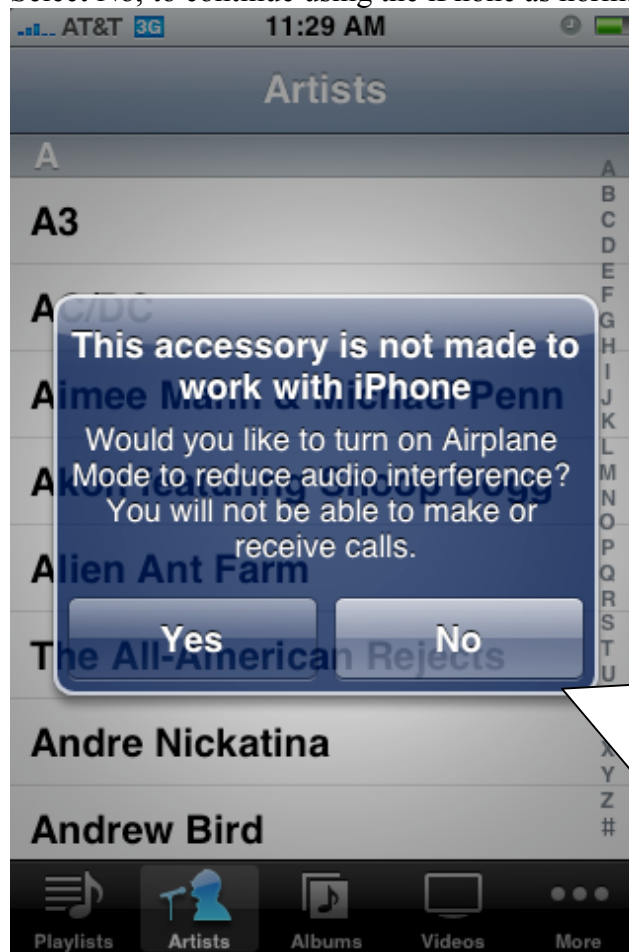
Your iPhone and your headset should now be paired together for Mobile Communications only.

Pairing a headset with an iPhone for Music

The following procedure will connect your stereo headset to your iPhone for Music listening and control.

Note: If you have already paired your headset to the iPhone for mobile communications, be sure to turn the Bluetooth setting to the off position on the iPhone. Once you have completed the following steps you can turn it back on.

1. Press and hold the Call Button on the left stem of the O ROKR until the indicator light on the inside of the right stem turns solid red.
(Review your headset's manual for instructions on how to enter pairing mode.)
2. Connect an icombi or odio Bluetooth Stereo adapter to the docking port of the iPhone.
3. An "Airplane Mode" Alert will appear on the iPhone as shown below. Select No, to continue using the iPhone as normal.



4. After a few moments the icombi or odio adapter will automatically pair with the O ROKR.
